I do hereby certify that I have surveyed that part of the West One-Half of the South East quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Thirty-seven (37) North, Range Sixteen (16) East of the Fourth (4th) Principal Meridam of the State of Wisconsin. The same being more particularly described as follows, to wit:-

Beginning at a point Two Hundred Forty-two (242) Feet South of a Cedar stake set for center of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Thirty-seven (37) North, Range Sixteen (16) East and on the North and South Quarter Line of said Section; thence South One Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen and Eighty Hundredths (1,819.80) Feet to the North Line of the Minneapolis, St Paul and Sault Ste Marie Railway right-of-way; thence Southeasterly along said North Line of the Minneapolis, St. Paul and Sault Ste Marie Railway right-of-way to the North and South Eighth Line of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-seven (27); thence North on this North and South Line Two Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-four (2,374) Feet; thence West on the East and West Quarter Line of said Section Twenty-seven (27) One Thousand One Hundred Sixteen and Seventy Hundredths (1,116.70) Feet; thence South Two Hundred Forty-two (242) Feet; thence West Two Hundred Eight and Fifty Hundredths (208.50) Feet to the place of beginning.

I do certify moreover that by order and direction of George Engelking, President, and Elmer Grimmer, Secretary, of Grimmer Land Company, I have subdivided the same into Lots and Streets under the name and title of the Plat of the Village of Engelking, and I have caused Cedar Monuments to be placed at the corners of all Lots and Blocks of this Plat.

I do further certify that this Plat is a correct representation of all exterior boundaries of the land surveyed and of the division thereon and that I have carefully complied with the provisions of Chapter One Hundred One (101) of the Revised Statues of 1878 of the State of Wisconsin in surveying, and sub-dividing, and mapping the same.
