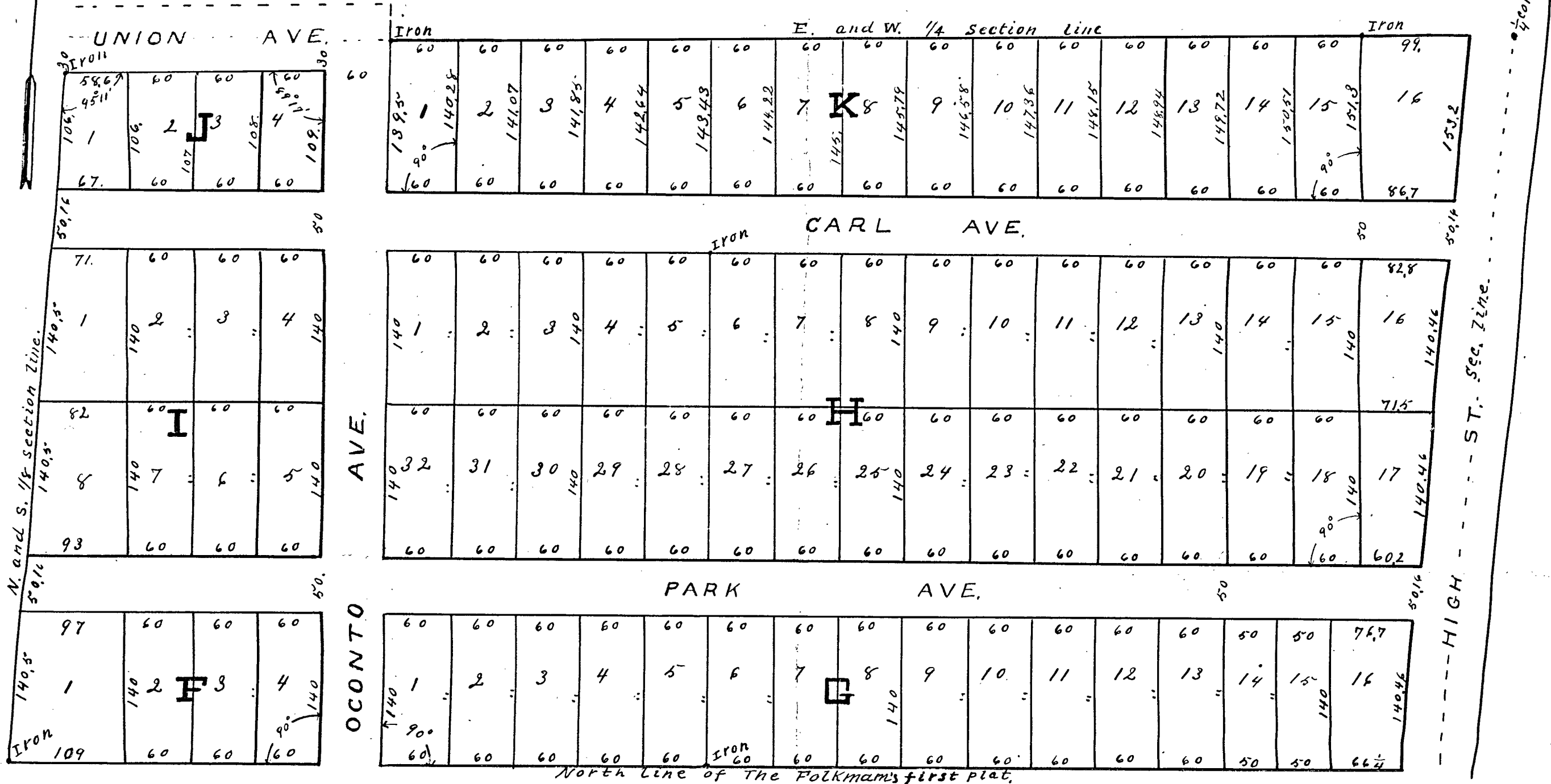


# MAP OF FOLKMAN'S 2<sup>ND</sup> PLAT.
