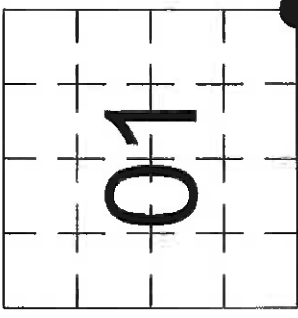

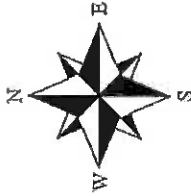
02/05/1975, William Kelly found a 6" X 6" Granite Monument frost heaved and unstable, and set a Bernitsen Monument for new monument flush with ground, then set Granite Monument next to Bernitsen Monument.

11/27/2012, I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, found a Bernitsen Monument leaning on Granite Monument, Granite Monument being up 12". Reset Granite Monument at base of Bernitsen Monument, up 10", and set 2 Iron ties.

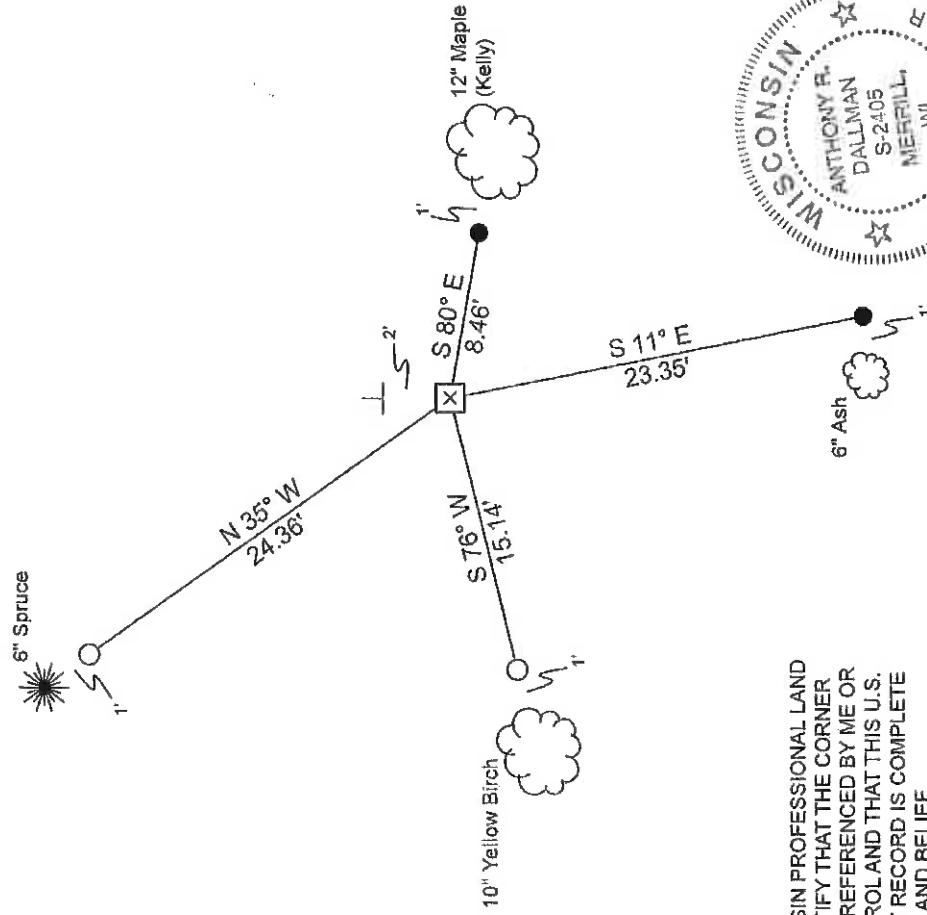
8/08/2024, I, Anthony R. Dallman, PLS-2405, found a Granite Monument, up 12", with Bernitsen Monument on the North side, up 24", and 2 existing ties. I accepted this location and set witness monuments, as shown in the sketch below, to further perpetuate the corner location.

STONE IS IN A SWAMP AND FROST HAD PUSHED IT UP INTO AN UNSTABLE POSITION.

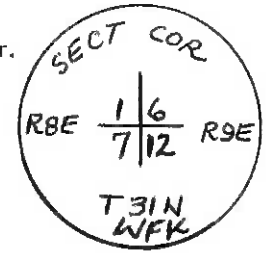
