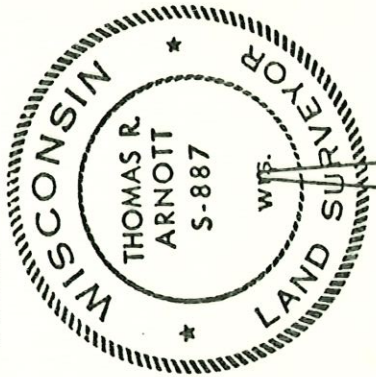


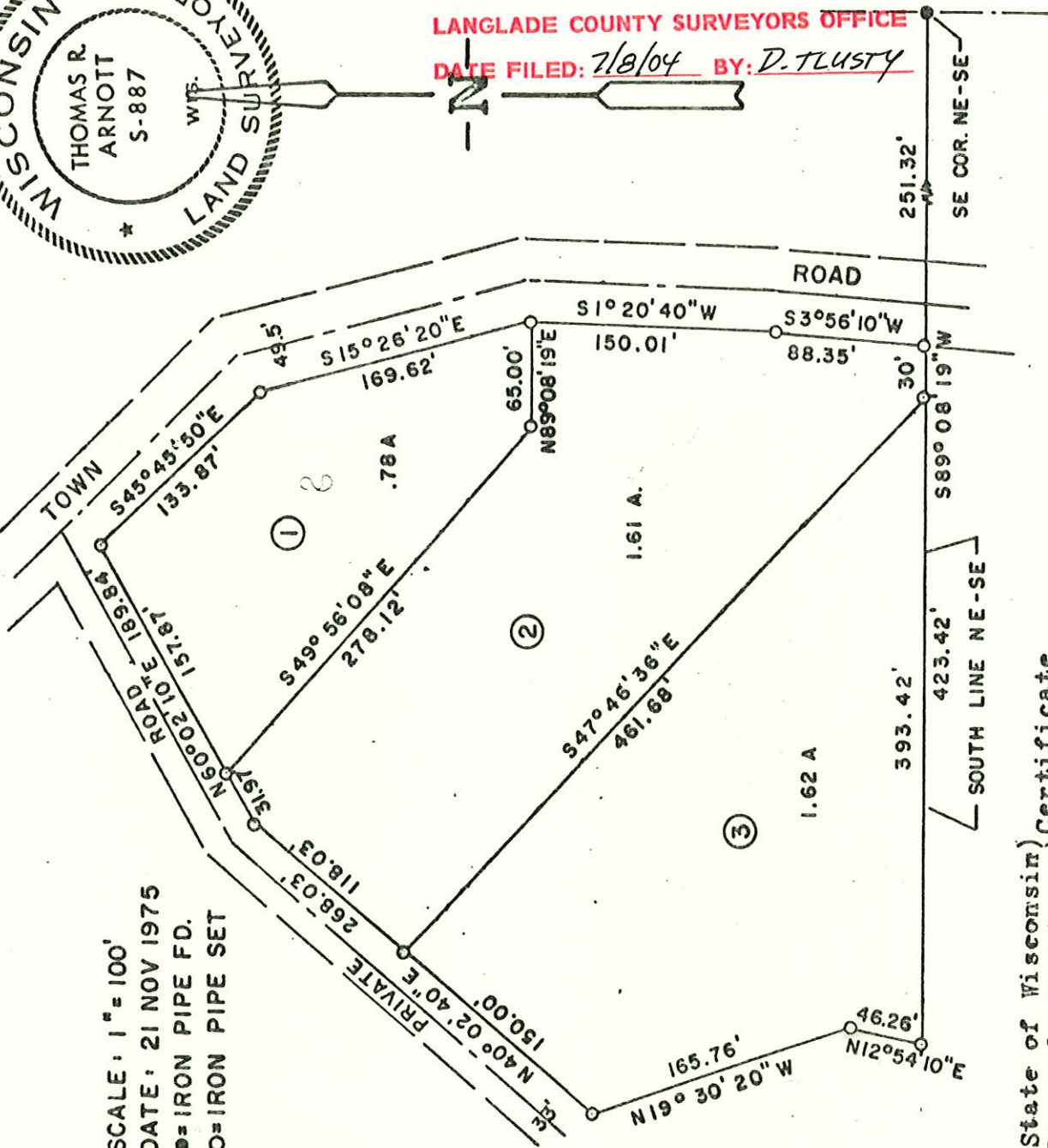

Arnott, Land Surveyor, hereby certify that I have surveyed, monumented and mapped that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 14, T34N, R12E, Town of Ainsworth, Langlade County, Wisconsin described as follows: Commencing at the SE corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence S89°08'19"W along the south line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 251.32 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue S89°08'19"W along the south line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 423.42 feet; thence N12°54'10"E 46.26 feet; thence N19°30'20"W 165.76 feet; thence N40°02'10"E 268.03 feet; thence N60°02'10"E 189.84 feet; thence S45°45'50"E 133.87 feet; thence S15°26'20"E 169.62 feet; thence S1°20'40"W 150.01 feet; thence S3°56'10"W 88.35 feet to the point of beginning.
