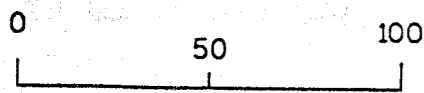

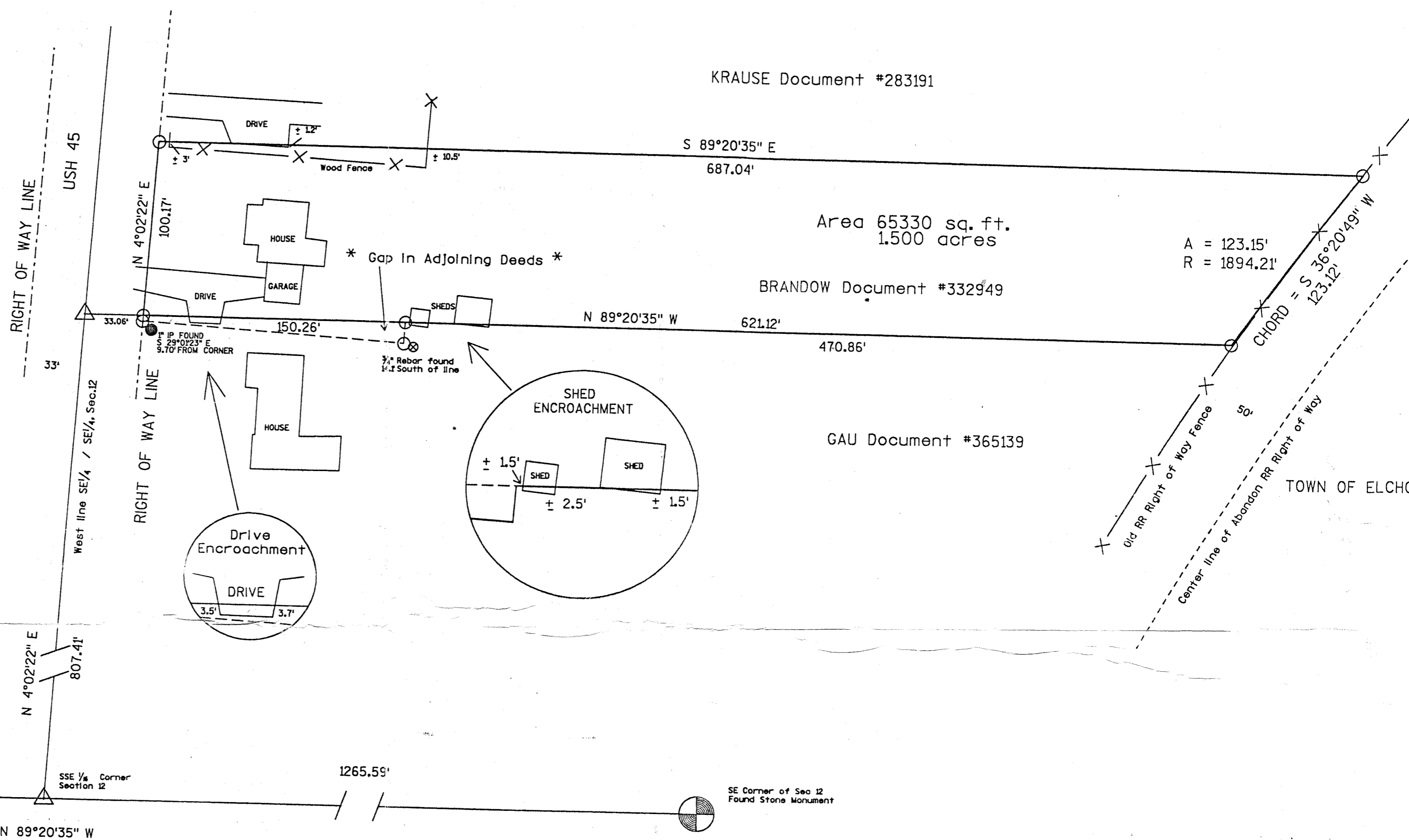

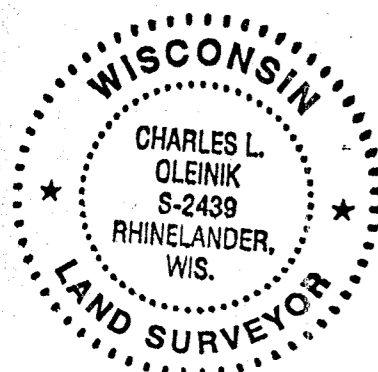
I, Charles L. Oleinik, Registered Land Surveyor in the State of Wisconsin, Hereby Certify:

That under direction of Jerry Brandow, owner, I have surveyed and mapped a parcel of land located in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Section 12, Town 34 North, Range 10 East Township of Elcho, Langlade County, Wisconsin, Described as follows;

Commencing at the Southeast Corner of said Section 12 marked by a Stone with an "X" on top; thence along the South Line of Section 12, N 89°20'35" W, 1265.59' to the Southwest Corner of the said SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4; thence along the West Line of the said SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, N 04°02'22" E, 807.41'; thence parallel to the South Line of said SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, S 89°20'35" E, 33.06' to a 1/4" Iron Pipe on the Easterly Right of Way line of USH 45 and the POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence along the Easterly Right of Way Line of USH 45, N 04°02'22" E, 100.17' to a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence parallel to the South line of Said SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 S 89°20'35" E, 687.04' to the Westerly line of the abandon Chicago and Northwestern Railway Right of Way, marked with a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence along the Westerly edge of said Right of Way, 123.15', along a curve concave Southeasterly with a radius of 1894.21' and a long chord of 123.12' bearing S 36°20'49" W to a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence parallel to the South line of said SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, N 89°20'35" W, 470.86' to a 1/4" Iron Pipe; thence continuing parallel to the South line of said SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, N 89°20'35" W, 150.26' to the POINT OF BEGINNING; Containing Approximately 1500 acres
