Langlade County I, B. F. Dorr, Surveyor, do hereby certify that by order and direction of Charles M. Upham and Julia F. Upham, his wife, and in full compliance with "chapter 101 Revised Statutes of 1878", I have surveyed and mapped a part of the south-east quarter of the north-east quarter, and a part of the north quarter of the north-east quarter, and a part of the north quarter of the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of the south-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section number Thirty (30), in Township number Thirty-two (32) North, of Range number Eleven (11) East, Fourth Principal Meridian, and in said County of Langlade, as shown on the annexed map.

At the north-east corner, and at the east quarter corner, and at the north-east corner of the south-east quarter of the north-east quarter of said section 30 respectively, I have set a pine post, each four (4) feet long, five (5) inches square at the top, and two (2) inches square at the bottom marked thus a on this map.

At the north-east corner of said section 30 I found the remaining parts of two original hearing trees, Spruce (stump) 12 inches diameter north 72 degrees west, 15 links; and a Birch (stub) 10 inches diameter north, 14 degrees east, 27 links.

At the east quarter post, I marked a pine stump 20 inches diameter south 40% degrees east, 294 links, and a yellow birch, 12 inches diameter north 261 degrees west, 241 links.

At the north-east corner of the SE; NE; I marked a hemlock stump 10 inches diameter, north 41 degrees east, 33; links, and a hemlock stump 12 inches diameter, north 67 degrees west, 36 links.

Variation of the needs 4 degrees East for bearings.

I set a pine post four feet long, 5 inches square at the top, and 2 inches square at the bottom marked thus a on this map: at each of the intersections of the west line of Wisconsin Street, and the east line of Union

Street, with the center lines of Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Avenues.

All the north and south lines are parellel with, and the east and west lines at right angles to the Milwaukee, Lake Shore and Western Railroad, except the lines of Traffic Street and of the Branch of the Milwaukee Lake Shore and Western Railroad.

The large figures placed at or near the center of each Block, represent the number of the Blocks; and the small figures placed at or near the center of each lot, represents the number of the lots.

The fine figures, thus 22, 42.66, 14, 50, 50.44, 55, 66, 41.24, 100.15, 132, 113, 165.67
10.25, 220, 240, &c. denote in feet and decimal parts of a foot the length and width
of lots, blocks, streets, avenues &c. between the points and the lines in
the direction in which they are written.

Traffic Street compages the space between a straight line from the north-west corner of lot 2 to a point 22 feet north of the north-west corner of lot 22, of Block 1 and the mouth line of the right of way of the Branch of the Milwaukee, Lake Shore and Western Railroad.

Eighth Avenue is subject to the conditions of a certain lease recorded in Langlade County in Vol. 1 of Mis. on page 365.
