

MAPOF THE VILLAGE OF

SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE.

State of Wisconsin Langlade County

I, B. F. Dorr Surveyor do hereby certify that by order and director of James T. Reeve, and Laura S. Reeve his wife, and in full compliance with chapter in Revised Statute of 1878, I have surveyed and mapped a part of the west half of the south-west quarter of section number Twenty-nine (20), and a part of the east half of the south-east quarter of section number Thirty (30), and a part of the north-east quarter of the north-east of section number Thirty-one (21), in Township number Thirty-two (32) North, of Range number Eleven (11) East, 4th Principal Meridian, and in the County of Langlade, and particularly described as follows. vix:

Commencing at the point on the stone at the section corner between said sections number 20, 30, and 31, marked thus 20 on the map and running thence west on the center line of First Avenue (Section line) to the east line of Michigan Street 2855 feet, thence south on the east line of said Michigan Street, to the south line of South Avenue 540.07 feet, thence west on the south line of said South Avenue to the west line of High Street 1244 feet, thence north on the west line of said High Street to the north line of Fifth Avenue 2618 feet, thence east on the north line of said Fifth Avenue, to the east line of Columbia Street 2256 feet, thence south on the east line of said Columbia Street, to the center line of said First Avenue (Section Line) 2077.44 feet, thence west on the said.

That to permanently establish the center line of First Avenue on the straight section line, I have set at the south-west corner of said section 29 a Bluish Stone is inches by as inches and 12 inches thick, and at the south-quarter post of said section 29 a Gray Boulder-not measured—size about 12 inches x 18 inches and 15 inches thick—wedging toward the top, and at the south quarter post of said section 30 a Bluish Stone 9 x 18 inches and 12 inches thick.

In the top of each of the above stones is a half inch hole 2 inches deep, filled with stone coal. Said hole is the point from which to measure.

Directly under said hole, and under the stone, is a one and quarter inch hole in the ground six inches deep filled with stone coal.

Over the hole in each stone is a tapering pine post four feet long, and five to five and half inches square at the top, with a nail head in the top, directly over the hole in the stone.

The top of said stones is four feet below the surface of the ground, except the stone at the said section corner, on which a block of wood sinches by sinches and four inches thick lies between the stone and the post.

The larg figure placed at or near the center of each Block, represent the number of the Blocks, and the small figures placed at or near the center of each let represent the number of the lots.

The fine figures thus 18.17, 28.08, 50, 74, 232, 140.81, 220, 444.10, 500, &c. denotes in feet and decimal parts of foot the length and width of lots, Blocks, Streets, Avenues &c. between the points, and the lines in the direction they are written.

All the north and south lines are parelell with, and the east and west lines at right angles to the Milwaukee Lake Shore and Western Railroad, except on First Avenue which run parelell with a straight line between the respective points on the three above specified stones, regardless of the course of the said Rail-road.

That the within map and the accompanying notes and explanations thereto, are correct representations of all the exterior Boundaries of the land surveyed and of the divisions therein made.
