I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT I HAVE SURVEYED, SUBDIVIDED AND PLATTED THE LAND SHOWN ON THIS MAP BY ORDER OF THE LANGLADE LUMBER COMPANY, A DOMESTIC CORPORATION, THE OWNER OF SAID LAND. THAT SAID MAP IS A CORRECT REPRESENTATION OF ALL BOUNDARIES OF LAND SURVEYED AND PLATTED AND THAT IN SURVEYING AND PLATTING THE SAME I HAVE FULLY COMPLIED WITH CHAPTER 236 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN FOR THE YEAR 1923 AND ALL ACTS AMMENDATORY THEREOF AND SUPPLEMENTAL THERETO. THE LAND SHOWN ON THIS MAP IS DESCRIBED AS A PART OF GOVERNMENT LOT 2, SECTION 14 T. 33N. R. 10E AS FOLLOWS: STARTING AT A POINT ON THE EAST SHORE OF DEEP WOODS LAKE WHERE THE SOUTH $\frac{1}{8}$ LINE INTERSECTS THE SHORE OF SAID LAKE, THENCE N $79^{\circ} 45' E$ 213.2' ALONG SAID $\frac{1}{8}$ LINE TO THE WEST LINE OF THE HIGHWAY, THENCE N $03^{\circ} 45' W$ 424.75' ALONG THE WEST LINE OF THE HIGHWAY, THENCE S $86^{\circ} 15' W$ 90.0' TO THE SHORE OF DEEP WOODS LAKE, THENCE NORTHWESTERLY, WESTERLY, AND SOUTHWESTERLY ALONG THE SHORE OF DEEP WOODS LAKE TO PLACE OF BEGINNING. THIS PLAT IS KNOWN AS THE SECOND ADDITION TO LONG LAKE-WATER POWER EXTENSION AND COMPRISES BLOCK 6. THIS BLOCK IS MADE UP OF FIVE LOTS NUMBERED 1 TO 5 CONSECUTIVELY. THE FIGURES IN THE CENTERS OF THE LOTS ARE THE NUMBERS OF THE SAME. THE DIMENSIONS OF THE LOTS ARE SHOWN BY THE FIGURES ON THE MARGIN THEREOF. • DENOTES IRON PINS.
