SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

I hereby certify that I have surveyed, subdivided and plotted the land shown on this map by order of Charles Heller, Receiver, Proviso State Bank, Maywood, Illinois, the owner of said land; that said map is a correct representation of all boundaries of land surveyed and plotted, and that in surveying and plotting the same I have fully complied with Ch. 236 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.
